## *WORSHIP & PROGRAMS("WP") SUMMER COORDINATOR OVERVIEW*

**Overview:** Our Worship and Programs Summer Coordinator would have the unique opportunity to own everything that happens on the stage at COH, unleashing their gifts, abilities and fun on COH for the glory of God. Additionally, the WP Coordinator will get to work in an exciting, youth-oriented Christian environment alongside other talented and passionate Christian college students. The hours can be long and the work challenging, but the WP Coordinator opportunity is very rewarding!

**Responsibilities:** The primary responsibility of the WP Coordinator is to work with COH Camp Director to oversee everything "big room" of the activity center. This role ensures that the worship is facilitated well and AM Jam is planned. The WP Coordinator can also be seen as the "voice" of camp, alongside the Camp Director, and helps campers engage during worship and AM Jam.

*Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:*

- Plan worship times during evening program
- Facilitate morning show (dances, skits, games, etc.)
- Lead a weekly discipleship group
- Run opening and closing campfires
- Oversee morning devotions
- Work with the rest of the Summer Leadership Team/Camp Director to lead and invest in the summer staff
- Other tasks as needed (every day is different at COH, and we all pitch in to help!)

**Growth:** A WP Coordinator can expect to develop or improve their skills in the areas of leadership, stage presence/facilitation, event organization, spiritual development, program planning, and much more. In addition, the WP Coordinator will gain valuable experience working in a fun environment that will seek to draw out the best in them, simultaneously encouraging them, and challenging them to improve. This will not only result in a strong resume builder and work references in the ministry, nonprofit and church spheres, but will create relationships that often last a lifetime.

**Experience** and/or skills in the following areas are **required** for the WP Coordinator position at Camp Oak Hill:

- Completion of 2 years of college (or equivalent experience) by summer start date
- Past worship leading experience
- Ability to clearly share the Gospel (an essential part of the COH story)
- Excellent time management skills and ability to work within deadlines

**Experience** and/or skills in the following areas are **preferred** for the WP Coordinator position at Camp Oak Hill:

- Emcee experience
- A passion for and natural ability as it relates to leading students/children in worship
- Basic understanding of the G Suite products (Google Drive, Docs, Sheets, etc.)
- Familiarity with a summer camp and/or ministry setting

**Details:** The WP Coordinator position will be based at Camp Oak Hill (Oxford, NC) from 5/26/20-8/1/20 (with an optional additional week through 8/8).
